Dear Ms. Golić,

regarding to your Letter, dated 10 of June, 2021., and the Letter from the Chair of the Implementation Committee under the Convention on Environmental Assessment, please find neccesarry information related to the Unit 7 TPP Tuzla as follows:

In accordance to the information provided on informal consultations, in the process of the Environmental permit renewal for Unit 7 TPP Tuzla, the EIA documentation required for renewal of the permit contains the result of modeling the transboundary impact on neighboring countries.

The Developer - Public Enterprise Elektroprivreda B&H Ltd. Sarajevo, in accordance to the Environmental Law (Official gazette of F B&H, No:15/21) submitted EIA documentation for the Environmental permit renewal 90 days before date of expire of the existing Environmental permit. For your information, valid Environmental permit will be expired on 18 July 2021.

In accordance to the Article 93 of Environmental Law (Renewal of the Environmental permit), Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism, responsible for issuing the environmental permit, renews environmental permit every five years for the units that are obliged for environmental permit. Operator is obliged to submit the Application for the Environmental permit renewal to the Federal Ministry in accordance to Article 86 of this Law. The Application for Environmental permit renewal is submitted 90 days before the expiration of the valid permit.

"Article 86 (Application for issuance of environmental permit) of the Environmental Law"

- (1) The application for the issuance of an environmental permit shall be submitted to the responsible ministry in one copy in writing and one copy on an electronic data storage medium.
- (2) The application for the issuance of an environmental permit shall contain:
- a) data on the applicant: name and seat of the operator or investor, ID number, name of the responsible person, telephone number and e-mail address;

- b) location of plants and facilities;
- c) a certificate from the competent tax administration that there are no outstanding financial obligations for penalties imposed for environmental violations.
- (3) The request referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be accompanied by documentation containing the following information:
- a) description of plant (the plan, description of plant, technical description of operation, plant capacity, etc.);
- b) description of basic and auxiliary raw materials, other substances and energy used or produced by the plant;
- c) description of the condition of the location of the plant;
- d) description of emission sources, nature and amount of emissions from plants into the environment (air, water, soil), ie report on the zero state, as well as an identification of significant impacts on the environment;
- e) a description of the proposed measures, technologies and other techniques to prevent or, if that is not possible, the reduction of emissions from the installation;
- f) a description of measures to prevent the production of waste as well as the recover of useful material from the waste produced by the installation; g) a description of other measures to comply with the basic obligations of the operator, in particular measures after the closure or demolition of the plant;
- h) a description of the planned emission reduction measures and a description of the planned monitoring;
- i) excerpt from the planning act;
- j) final water act;
- k) non-technical summary
- l) conceptual design;
- m) waste management plan;

With the application for renewal of environmental permit, in addition to identification information, address, contact phone and e-mail address, operator should delivere:

a) a final water act, if the construction of the plant or plant has not been completed,

After analyzing all the collected information, the responsible Ministry, will issue an environmental permit within 60 days, or rejects the application for an environmental permit.

The public shall be informed about the initiation of the procedure for the environmental permit renewal within the deadlines and in the manner prescribed by Article 40 of this Law. In this regard, the procedure for the Environmental permit renewal for the Unit7 of TPP Tuzla begins on July 15th 2021: https://www.fmoit.gov.ba/bs/okolisne-dozvole/javne-rasprave-i-javni-uvidi

In accordance with Article 40 (Public participation in the decision-making process)

The Federal Ministry also ensures public participation in decision-making.

After initiating the administrative procedure, the responsible ministry informs the public about:

- the application for the issuance of an environmental permit and the proposed activities and technologies of the applicant;
- manner of public participation public insight;
- the place where the documentation can be reviewed;
- environmental information relevant to the proposed activities;
- deadline for submission of remarks, proposals, opinions and questions.

* Within 30 days from the date of publication of the information, the public (interested parties) can submit written remarks, information, analysis, or opinion that they consider relevant for subject and procedure.

The results of public participation are taken into account when making a decision, and the public is informed via the website of the responsible ministry, while interested parties submitted their comments during the public participation procedure are notified in written, within the deadlines applicable to the applicant.

In accordance with the ESPOO Convention, Focal point of the B&H should submit the Notification form and EIA documentataion for Unit 7 TPP Tuzla to Focal point of Republic of Serbia, Republic of Croatia and Montenegro. From Republic of Serbia, Republic of Croatia and Montenegro are expected to submit a confirmation of receipt of Notification Form and EIA documentation to the Focal Point of B&H, Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism and developer (JP Elektroprivreda BiH d.d. Sarajevo).

As indicated in the Notification Form, from affected parties are expected to submit their comments on the received EIA documentation within 30 days from the date of receipt. The EIA documentation contains the chapter dealing with possible transboundary impact of Unit 7 emissions on the affected parties.

According to above mentioned, B&H ensured the participation of the affected parties.

The relevant outputs of this participation (comments and suggestions) will be included in the final decision on the extension of the environmental permit.

The Ministry will deliver the renewed environmental permit to the affected parties upon process completion.

Description of proposed activity (e.g. technology used)	Generation of electricity with burning of lignite by the technology of burning of coal dust with over-critical parameters of steam (275 bar, 600/610°C) in such named BoA (Betriebsoptimierte Anlagen) technology, with the power of 450 MW on generator's terminal in the condensation regime of work and net degree of usage of 42.64% of the nominal parameters of the unit. As part of Unit 7, there is a foreseen heating station for remote heating of the city of Tuzla and the surrounding areas, with the nominal power of 270 MWth. With such power, the electric power of the unit, with equal load on the boiler, is decreased for approximately 60 MW, and the degree of usage of fuel heat is increased to over 62%.
Description of purpose of proposed activity	The TPP Tuzla has very old thermal units in the electric energy system of BiH and they are nearing the end of their lifetime after

revitalization, and in regard to environmental protection they do not fit into EU norms. Unit 7 will replaced units 2x 32 MW are not working since 2002, and the existing units: Unit 3 - 100 MW, Unit 4 - 200 MW, Unit 5 -

200 MW.

A special importance of construction of replacement units is providing of long-term supplying with hating energy of the surrounding cities around the TPP Tuzla, since at present the supplying of heating energy is performed from the existing units, which are to stop working in the upcoming period. The replacement units are planned as TPP-TO units and are foreseen to work in cogeneration, which provides for a long-term supplying of the neighbouring cities with the heating energy and has a very positive effect on the environment, since a number of individual boiler rooms in these cities will be replaced.

Rationale for proposed activity (e.g. socio-economic basis, physical geographic basis)

Keeping of the number of jobs and due to the use of the best available technologies, reduction pollution (SO₂, NOx and PM) and noise.

The construction of Unit 7 provides:

- replacement for the existing units that go out of operation in accordance with documents OPT-OUT and NERP BIH
- ensures the continuity of coal production and the restructuring of the Kreka Mine in within the Concern JP EP BiH.
- Unit 7 is being built as a thermos powerheating unit and is intended for work in cogeneration, which provides long-term heat supply of the surrounding cities, and after the closure of Unit 3 and Unit 4 (units from which heating is provided today).
- Increasing energy efficiency and, accordingly, reducing greenhouse gas emissions (hereinafter GHG) (old units have a degree of efficiency of about 30%, and the replacement Unit 7 in condensing mode> 42%, and in cogeneration> 62%).
- Unit 7 is designed in accordance with the best available techniques for combustion plants LCP BAT (Best Available Techniques) as well as in accordance with
